Haysville Alternative High School Students Volunteer to Help

Haysville, KS – Haysville Alternative High School students performed community service for the City of Haysville, assisting with various projects around town. On Friday, April 23, approximately one hundred students worked for three hours helping city staff by: painting bleachers, washing equipment, power washing, cleaning facilities, assembling publications, painting fire hydrants, and picking up trash in the parks and ditches.
