# Understanding the Solid Waste Regulations

### **The following is a brief overview of the solid waste regulations, as they apply to residential properties.**

Each owner of a home, apartment or duplex must provide a trash container for the dwelling and the trash collector.

All containers shall be either a thirty or thirty-five gallon container; or an eighty to one-hundred gallon, self-contained wheel container.

All solid waste shall be entirely enclosed within the container(s) and grass clippings or other yard waste in plastic sacks where used. The area around the containers shall be kept neat and clear and free of solid waste.

All solid waste shall be stored so that:

- It does not attract birds, rats, flies, mosquitoes or other disease carriers;
- It does not provide shelter or a breeding place for disease carriers;
- It does not create a health or safety hazard;
- It is not unsightly; and
- The production of offensive odors is minimized.

No garbage and trash receptacles shall be stored in a front yard a distance of more than six feet from the front of the house. This requirement does not apply on those days that refuse collection has been scheduled for that location.
