## Community Building

The Haysville Community Building is located in the Historic District at 130 E. 2nd St. The building is a great place to hold gatherings including but not limited to: Birthday parties, weddings & receptions, retirements, demonstrations, conferences, and much more! The building is available Sunday through Friday from 9 am to 10 pm and on Saturdays from 9 am to 11 pm. The building has a capacity for 80 people. Ten tables and 80 chairs are provided along with two stoves, a refrigerator, microwave, and restroom facilities. The building is non-smoking and kitchen utensils/dinnerware are not provided. No alcohol is allowed on City property.

## Haysville Senior Center


The Haysville Senior Center is available to rent for senior functions only. Call the Senior Center Director at 529-5903 for information and criteria on renting this facility.
