
### David & Gerry Straub Gathering Room

# Migitire Jour Memories!!

## WITH KELLY SMITH- 16 HANDS PHOTOGRAPHY Monday, July 15th starting at 9:00 A.M.

Sign up with SC staff for a Digitizing Day at the Haysville Senior Center!

Bring up to 20 slides or photos, or five film negative strips, and have them digitized on the spot! It's easy, affordable, and you'll receive your downloads same day. Not sure how to do all that "tech stuff"? Don't worry, I'll help you with each step, no need to call your grandkids!

How does it work? Sign up for an appointment, bring your media with you; and I'll take care of scanning and editing your memories. Once they're processed, you'll receive a link on your phone or through an email where you can download your photos. If you need help downloading them, I can help you with that!

How much does it cost? There is a service fee of \$5.00 per order (normally \$15.00). Each slide or photo costs \$1 to scan, crop, and edit for color and/or small blemishes. Payment can be made using cash, a check or PayPal. There's no minimum number of slide/photos, but the maximum to fit into the 30 minute appointment is 20.

What if I have more than 20? For larger orders and VHS tapes, I can take your order to my office after the event. The service fee is still \$5.00 if they're brought during the event. VHS/DVD transfer pricing is \$10 for the first ten minutes, and then fifty cents per minute after that. Maximum charge is \$25. If the tape is blank, there is no charge.

What if I have A LOT of slides/photos/negatives? For large orders, there are different levels of scanning available at a lower rate (these don't include cropping, color correction or blemish repair). They vary from thirty cents to a dollar each.



### Center Reminders

- Paymer ts for all programs that require a fee are due at time of sign up. Fees are <u>non-refundable and</u> <u>non-transferrable</u> to another program <u>AFTER</u> the sign up deadline has passed as <u>food/supplies have</u> <u>already</u> been purchased. After a deadline has passed, you may give your ticket to <u>another member</u>.
- Credit card transactions are now accepted for all programs, membership & rentals. Multiple
  transactions will be required if you wish to pay for more than one event at a time, as these funds must
  be turned in at different times & tracked in multiple locations (this same policy goes for check
  payments as well). Please note that refunds for credit card transactions will be submitted through the
  City and can take up to two weeks before a check will be mailed to your home address.
- We offer two different Bingo games:
  - Regular \$2.00 Bingo
  - \$3 Card Bingo. This game is played with playing cards and each player must bring (1) Dollar Bill &
     (8) Quarters. The center will not break change.
